

YMCA SILVER SPRING COMMUNITY IMPACT SUMMARY

YOUTH DEVELOPMENT: Nurturing children through programs, classes and events that promote character development, healthy lifestyles and academic achievement.

- ✓ **Over 4000 youth and teens** who participate in early learning, after school programs, summer camp, swim team, youth sports and aquatics programs.
- ✓ On average, we provide over **\$72,000** in scholarships awarded for children to participate in subsidized programming for early learning, after school programs, youth sports and aquatic classes
- ✓ YMCA Silver Spring offers swim lessons for home-schooled children and serves over **100 children** annually.

HEALTHY LIVING: Supporting individuals, seniors, parents and families by providing programs, classes and events for a healthy lifestyle.

- ✓ Over 1,700 members participate in our Wellness and Aquatics programs
- ✓ We provide 70 free wellness classes to members during the year.
- ✓ Our Better Balance Class has enabled 240 seniors to maintain strength and balance for activities of daily living.
- ✓ Hosts the Sub District Championship Swim Meet for the YMCA Swimming Chesapeake and Potomac Swim League.

SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY: Partnering with community leaders and organizations to provide leadership and support in addressing the needs of our children, teens and families.

- ✓ Provides approximately \$147,000 in scholarships to those in need, so they may participate in YMCA membership and programs.
- ✓ YMCA Silver Spring volunteers and partners with **Youth and Family Services** to host the annual **Angel Tree** which provides holiday gifts for **over 100 youth** in Montgomery County.
- Responded to the devastating apartment fire in Silver Spring by providing free camp services for affected families and serving as a donation collection center (collecting soft goods for victims).

- ✓ **JTCC (Junior Tennis Championship Club)** Delivered tennis instruction through summer camps, clinics and competitive tournaments, to over 350 participants annually.
- ✓ Kaboom and Delta Airlines Replaced our aging playground to better youth in our community.
- ✓ **Sligo Creek Elementary School** Delivered the "Fun Friday" which provides structured, age appropriate physical activity during the school recess time.

CONTRIBUTIONS TO YMCA "SIGNATURE PROGRAMS"

- ✓ We implement the Physical Healthy Driven (PHD) program with over 60 school-age children to teach creative & fun ways to exercise. Kids participate in exercise from warm-up stretching to high intensity group games.
- ✓ Sends more than **300** kids to the YMCA **Annual Thingamajig Invention Convention** where children create eco-friendly inventions & compete with other young inventors for fun prizes. This event introduces them to the world of STEAM −-science, technology, performing arts, aeronautics, engineering, active fitness and play, nutrition, and going green.
- ✓ Along with other Y's across the country, we host a local annual Healthy Kids Day, a free community health event for kids, which encourages healthy habits for children and families, active play and physical activity.
