PRO INSTRUCTION (Tennis & Pickleball & Pickleball Drop-in)

- All lesson and adult clinic registrations must be canceled no later than 24 hours to the scheduled start time to receive a credit, if applicable, to your Court Reserve account.
- All Pickleball Drop-in registrations must be canceled no later than 3 hours prior to the scheduled start time to receive a credit, if applicable, to your Court Reserve account. Not showing for a registered Drop-in event or canceling less than 3 hours prior to the event may incur a No-show / Late Cancellation fee.
- Jr programs and Pickleball Leagues must be canceled 7 days prior to the start date of the session (20% fee applies if canceled within 7 days of start date). Should you need to miss a class due to an unforeseen circumstance (emergency or medical) please inform the pro in advance.
- Modify or cancel your registrations through your Court Reserve account. (Court Reserve > Profile (your name top right) > My Events)
 If you are experiencing issues with the online system, please call your branch directly.
- Reach out to your pro directly, no later than 24 hours prior to the scheduled start time, if you need to cancel a lesson.
- Low Enrollment Cancellation: In the event that enrollment does not reach the minimum participation for a program to run, you will receive a notification at least 24 hours prior to the start of the scheduled class that it is canceled. If the activity is canceled by the pro, you will receive a credit to your Court Reserve account.

TENNIS & PICKLEBALL COURT RESERVATIONS

- To cancel without penalty, all court reservations must be canceled no later than 24 hours prior to the scheduled start time. You will receive a credit, if applicable, of fees paid to your Court Reserve account. (Court Reserve > Profile (your name top right) > My Reservations)
- Reservations are non-transferable to other members.
- Weather Cancellation: In the event of inclement weather, call the front desk, (BCC 301-530-3725) (SS 301-585-2120), at least 2 hours prior to the start of your reservation to cancel without penalty. If applicable, a credit will be issued to your Court Reserve account.

WEATHER CANCELLATION
